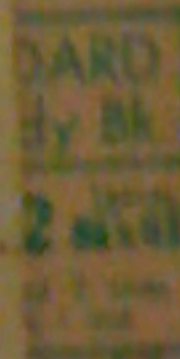

Get a Policeman for Sale

Explain procedure to helpers
clearly before door opens.

The buyer presents card when
a sale is made and the
name of the article and its
price are written clearly on
the card keeping shilling
and pence in their right
column straight.

Cards are to be made of
wheatbix cartons and measure
about 8" x 4". Cards must

be stamped with Kindergarten
stamp

Six checkers to work in pairs
are really necessary - one checks
the articles with the card while
the other tots up the amount.

Lots of newspapers and string
must be sent with the lorry

The buyer then after the purchase
passes on to the Cashier, presents
his or her card and pays his
a/c.
